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SANTA EULÀRIA IBIZA MARATHON RULES

Article 1. ORGANIZER

Talentum Group organizes the 10th edition of the Santa Eulària Ibiza Marathon on Saturday, April 10, 2027.

Article 2. DATE AND TIME

Marathon.

On Saturday, April 10, 2027, the Santa Eulària Ibiza Marathon will take place in the afternoon. The marathon will start at 3:45 PM and the finish line will close at 9:10 PM, with the maximum time allowed to complete the race being 5 hours and 25 minutes.

22K.

The 22K race will start at 5:15 PM from Santa Gertrudis.

12K.

The 12K will start at 16:00h from Marina Santa Eulària.

Article 3. DISTANCE, COURSE AND OFFICIALS

Marathon.

The distance is 42,195 meters and the circuit is certified by the Royal Spanish Athletics Federation. The race is included in the National Calendar. Throughout the course, all kilometers will be marked. The Judges of the Royal Spanish Athletics Federation and/or the Athletics Federation of the Balearic Islands will be responsible for ensuring compliance with the sporting regulations and these rules.

The distance is 22K. Throughout the course, all kilometers will be marked.

The distance is 12K. During the course, all kilometers will be marked.

Article 4. PARTICIPATION

The race is open to athletes of any nationality, federated or not, who are 18 years old on April 10, 2027, the date on which the Santa Eulària Ibiza Marathon will take place.

Each runner participates in this race on foot under their own responsibility and has a sufficient level of physical condition to face a race of such characteristics.

Article 5. REGISTRATION

Registration for the Santa Eulària Ibiza Marathon is personal and non-transferable and can only be completed through the official event website www.ibizamarathon.es.

Registration implies acceptance of these rules. Under no circumstances may it be transferred or sold to another person, friend or family member due to being unable to attend on race day. Failure to comply with this rule invalidates participation in the race, and the organization has the right to exclude the person responsible from participating in future editions.

Article 5.1 Prices and registration periods

Registration opens on May 18, 2026.

Before this date, a special 10th Anniversary EARLY BIRD offer will be available exclusively for those who have previously participated in any of the nine earlier editions. Access to this promotion will be via a personalized single-use code, valid from April 30 to May 15, 2026, under the following conditions:

Once registration is open, the planned prices are as follows:

The organization reserves the right to modify/extend/reduce/close the established registration period and will duly communicate any change through its corporate channels.

Each distance has a maximum number of bibs. If the quota is reached, the registration period for that distance will be closed.

During Friday, April 17, on-site registrations may be made at the incident point of the runner's expo ONLY IF it is announced that bibs are still available. These registrations will be subject to the "late registration" rate. In this case of on-site purchase, bibs will not be personalized, nor is the desired size of the participant's complimentary T-shirt guaranteed.

Registration is personal and non-transferable. Once registration has been completed, the race fee will not be refunded for any reason. Each runner participates in the race under their sole responsibility. During the registration process, the runner accepts, under their absolute responsibility, that they are in perfect health,

that they will participate, and that they possess a sufficient level of physical condition to complete the race.

IMPORTANT: The registration fee does NOT include the €5 RFEA license, which must be paid during the bib purchase process. Those participants who, by holding an RFEA license, a regional license from the Federation where the competition takes place, or a Runner Plus Card, do not need to process a Day License must select this when registering.

Article 5.2 Registration requirements

All athletes participating in the Santa Eulària Ibiza Marathon (in marathon distance) must hold a Day License except for those athletes who hold an annual RFEA License, a regional license from the Federation where the competition takes place and/or a Runner Plus Card.

The Day License will be processed through the Race Organization at the time of registration, with a cost included in the price of €5.

Those participants who, by holding an RFEA license, a regional license from the Federation where the competition takes place, or a Runner Plus Card, do not need to process a Day License must select this when registering.

Article 5.3 Change of holder

The organization offers the possibility of making a name change. It can be requested by contacting info@ibizamarathon.com. The new runner must comply with the provisions of these rules, the content of which they will accept when the name change becomes effective. The cost of the change of holder is €12 for administrative expenses. As of March 1, 2027, no changes of holder will be made.

If an already registered athlete wishes to request a change of distance, they must do so by contacting info@ibizamarathon.com. If the change is to a shorter distance, it will be processed at no cost. If it is to a longer distance, the organization will indicate

the steps to follow and the athlete must pay the current rate of the chosen distance (the organization reimbursing the amount previously paid). This change WILL ONLY BE POSSIBLE if there are places available in the chosen distance. As of March 1, 2027, no distance changes will be made.

Article 6. CANCELLATION OF REGISTRATION AND REFUND

The organization will refund the registration fee in the event of physical injury (not if an illness is contracted) that makes it impossible to practice sports, upon presentation of a medical certificate through the email info@ibizamarathon.com from the same email address used to register.

Only requests made within the indicated period and providing complete documentation and information will be processed.

The deadline to request a refund is March 1, 2027.

Article 7. BIB COLLECTION AND RUNNER'S BAG

The collection of the runner's bag and bib will take place at the Santa Eulària Ibiza Marathon Runner's Expo (the location and schedule will be communicated sufficiently in advance).

To collect the bib, it will be necessary to present an ID card or passport. In the event of collecting another person's bib, a copy of the registered person's ID and signed authorization must be provided.

Marathon.

On race day, Saturday, April 18, from 1:45 PM to 3:00 PM, the organization will provide a last-minute bib collection point next to the marathon start at Ibiza Port. During this time, it will not be possible to make any kind of change (starting wave, incident, etc.) nor will the runner's bag be delivered, which may be requested afterward at the post-finish area.

The organization reserves the right to change the location or schedule of bib delivery, which will be communicated to registered participants sufficiently in advance.

The race day, Saturday April 18th, from 2:00 p.m. to 4:45 p.m., the organization will set up a last-minute bib number delivery point next to the 22K start line in Santa Gertrudis. During this time, it will not be possible to make any type of change (starting area, incident...) nor will the runner's bag be delivered, which can be requested later in post-finish.

The organization reserves the right to change the location or time of delivery of bib numbers, which will be communicated to those registered well in advance.

The collection of the runner's bag and race bib will be at the Santa Eulària Ibiza Marathon Runner's Fair. The location of the fair will be communicated well in advance. On the same day of the race, from 13:00h, closing time of the Fair, a last minute delivery stand will be set up.

To collect the bib number it will be necessary to present the ID or Passport. In case of picking up the number of another person, it is necessary a copy of the ID of the registered person and signed authorization.

The organization reserves the right to change the location or time of delivery of bib numbers, which will be communicated to those registered well in advance.

Article 8. TIMING

Timing will be carried out through the chip system that all participants will receive when collecting their runner's bag. The chip will be integrated into the bib and must not be separated from it at any time or tampered with.

It is not necessary to return the chip once the race has finished.

There will be timing points at the start and finish, as well as three intermediate points that will be communicated sufficiently in advance, with prior knowledge of the judges.

Article 9. STARTING WAVES

Marathon.

The organization will assign participants to starting waves based on the information provided by each athlete in their registration, taking into account sporting and safety criteria.

There will be five organized starting waves that will be graphically marked on the bib itself. It is forbidden to access a wave that does not correspond to the one indicated on the bib. The organization reserves the right to remove from the classification all athletes who start in a different wave from the one selected.

It is not possible to make changes of wave at the Runner's Expo.

The organization will assign starting waves based on the information provided by each athlete during registration, taking into account sporting and safety criteria.

There will be organized starting waves clearly indicated on the bib. It is forbidden to enter a wave that does not correspond to the one indicated on the bib. The organization reserves the right to remove from the classification any athletes who start in a different wave than assigned.

It is not possible to change starting waves at the Runner's Expo.

There will be five organized starting waves that will be graphically marked on the bib itself. It is forbidden to access a wave that does not correspond to the one indicated on the bib. The organization reserves the right to remove from the classification all athletes who start in a different wave from the one selected.

It is not possible to make changes of wave at the Runner's Expo.

Article 10. CUT-OFF TIMES

Marathon.

A maximum time of 5:25 hours is established to complete the marathon distance. In addition, the organization together with the FAIB judges will establish a series of cut-off points on the course at the following times:

- KM 10: 5:00 PM
- KM 20: 6:15 PM
- KM 27: 7:15 PM
- KM 30: 7:45 PM
- KM 37: 8:40 PM

These times will be strictly enforced for the safety and integrity of all athletes. Any runner who exceeds the time established at these points will be disqualified by the race judge and their bib will be removed by judges' staff or by the organization. This runner will be officially out of the race.

A maximum time of 3:00 hours is established to complete the 22K distance.

These times will be strictly enforced for the safety and integrity of all athletes. Any runner exceeding the established time limits will be disqualified by the race officials,

and their bib will be removed by officials or organization staff. This runner will be officially out of the race.

12K.

A maximum time of 1:45 hours is established to complete the 12,000 metre distance. The finish line will close at 5:45 PM. A time of respect and good faith will be kept, but after this time, if the participants are overtaken by the broom car, closing the race, they will be officially out of the race. Their bibs will be taken away by the organisation's staff.

Article 11. REFRESHMENT STATIONS

Marathon.

Along the marathon course, liquid refreshment points combined with others offering liquid + solid refreshments will be located approximately every 5 kilometers. In addition, there will be reinforcement points in the final section.

The specific location and products at each point will be communicated to the athletes sufficiently in advance.

Along the 22K course, there will be liquid refreshment points combined with others offering liquid + solid food approximately every 5 kilometers.

The exact locations and products will be communicated to participants in advance.

During the 12K circuit, there will be an aid station around km 7 and another post-finish line. The specific location and the products of each point will be communicated to the athletes well in advance.



Article 12. MEDICAL SERVICES

The Santa Eulària Ibiza Marathon will have a medical and safety arrangement. Medical services will be located along the course, as well as in the start and finish area, where the field hospital will be located.

The bib will have an emergency telephone number printed on it that the runner may use in case of feeling unwell or having a medical emergency.

Article 13. CLASSIFICATIONS, PRIZES AND TROPHIES

Marathon.

The organization will establish cash prizes for the first three overall finishers in the men's and women's categories. The amounts will be the same for both men and women.

The prizes will be paid 90 days after the race is held, with the corresponding tax withholdings, and once the results of any anti-doping control, if applicable, are known. In the event of a positive result, these athletes will lose all right to the prize and will be removed from the classifications.

There will be category classifications, but no trophies. Only the top three men and top three women in the overall classification will receive trophies.

Article 14. INSURANCE

The organization will have a civil liability insurance policy in accordance with current legislation. In addition, all participants will be covered by an accident insurance policy. Participation in this event is under the responsibility and at the participant's own risk, as they have voluntarily registered to participate. At the time of registration, the runner declares that they are in perfect health in order to take part in the race. The organization is not responsible for any damage that participants may cause during the race, to themselves or to third parties.

Article 15. RACE SAFETY

Safety on public roads will be the responsibility of the security forces and authorities involved in the proper development of the race in Ibiza and of the organization itself. Medical services will be authorized to withdraw any participant who is in evident risk conditions.

Motorized vehicles or bicycles that do not belong to the organization and are not duly authorized are strictly prohibited.

Article 16. CHANGES / ALTERATIONS

If necessary, the Relevant Authority responsible for the race (Civil Protection, Local Police and/or Public Space of Ibiza Town Hall), whether for safety reasons or force majeure, has the authority to modify the place of the start/finish and the start and finish times of any of the distances. The organization reserves the right to make changes in justified cases or in cases of force majeure, understood as those in which

the relevant authorities require it (in this case, no refund of the registration fee will be made).

The organization reserves the right to make any changes to these rules if it deems it appropriate, and must communicate this on the official race website and in the information delivered to the runner, either by email or physically.

In the event of extraordinary weather conditions or force majeure not attributable to the organization and which make it impossible to hold the race, the organization will assume no responsibility and will not make any refund of the registration fee.

Article 17. ACCEPTANCE OF THE RULES

All participants accept each and every one of the articles of these rules and honestly undertake not to start before the official start and to complete the full distance before crossing the finish line. The organization reserves the right to act and take the appropriate measures in the event of any unsporting, disrespectful, unfair or violent behavior.

Article 18. AETIB

This event has financial support from AETIB.

Article 19. LIABILITY WAIVER

All participants, by the mere act of registering, declare that they are aware of and accept these Rules and the Liability Waiver and Data Protection Document. In case of doubt, the Organization's criteria shall prevail.

Liability Waiver and Protection Document

By registering, the participant declares that:

"I am in optimal health condition to participate in the Santa Eulària Ibiza Marathon. Furthermore, I release the organization, sponsors or other participating institutions

from all liability for any accident or injury that I may suffer before, during and/or after the sporting event, waiving from this moment any legal action against any of said entities. During the course of the competition I will cooperate as much as possible with the organization in order to avoid personal accidents.”

Nevertheless, the organization recommends that runners enjoy sport responsibly and undergo a medical examination prior to the race, with every participant accepting the risk arising from sporting activity.

Article 20. ACCEPTANCE OF IMAGE AND DATA USE

The runner authorizes the organization to make advertising use of data, photos, videos and/or any other type of audiovisual material in which they may appear, accepting the publication of my name in the race classification, in the media and/or on the Internet, without expecting any payment, compensation or remuneration whatsoever for this concept. In addition, this material and information may be used in later editions of the race held and may be transferred to any sponsor of the race, who, by themselves or through third parties, process, exclusively for sporting, promotional or commercial purposes, their personal data, as well as their image within the race through photographs, videos, etc.

In accordance with the provisions of Organic Law 15/1999, of December 13, on the Protection of Personal Data, all personal data provided by participants and the images obtained during the race will be stored in files belonging to Talentum Group, as organizer, and Sportmaniacs, as registration platform, for the purpose of managing participation in the race, as well as the promotion, distribution and dissemination of the same. Participants may exercise their rights of access, rectification, cancellation and objection at any time by sending a written request together with a copy of their ID to the registered office at C/ Muñoz Degraín number 3 pta 7, Valencia.

Note: Anything not provided for in these Rules shall be governed by the General Competition Rules of the FAIB and RFEA and/or by the criteria of the organization itself. Therefore, the organization reserves the right to modify/correct/complete these rules, by which the race shall be governed.
