Regulation

"10Km We Run Rome" XIV Edition, 31 December '25

Atleticom SSD.r.L. organises on Wednesday 31 December 2025 the XIV edition of We Run Rome, a competitive running race event over the distance of 10 km and non-competitive over the distances of 10 and 5 km, held under the aegis of FIDAL and included in the national calendar. It enjoys the patronage of CONI, Sport and Health, Roma Capitale and Regione Lazio.

By registering to the race, the athlete declares that he has read and fully accepts these regulations.

The competition regulations may be subject to change following the dispositions given by the competent institutions; we therefore invite all participants to consult them and keep up to date. Any changes will be duly communicated to registered athletes via the event website www.werunrome.com or via the event's official social pages.

1 - Meeting point

The We Run Rome village will be open from 10:00 am in the area adjacent to the 'Nando Martellini' Terme di Caracalla Stadium. Participants will have the opportunity to visit the various stands of the event partners and to taste the proposals of the food trucks present.

The start of the competitive and non-competitive 10 km race will be given in Via delle Terme di Caracalla at 14:00. The 5 km non-competitive race will start a few minutes later.

2 - 10K Competitive Participation Requirements

Athletes registered in Italy

In accordance with the "Rules for the organisation of events" issued by the FIDAL, the competitive event is open to Italian **and foreigner** athletes who have completed their 16 years of age or older (thousandth of age), having the following requirements:

- 1. Athletes registered in 2025 with FIDAL affiliated clubs who have reached the age of 16;
- 2. Athletes registered with a Sports Promotion Body (Athletics section), recognised by CONI and in possession of a Runcard EPS www.runcard.com (valid as sports insurance and authorisation to compete), limited to athletes who have reached the age of 20 (thousandth of age); the participation is however subject to:

A valid medical certificate of specific agonistic fitness for athletics, which must be presented to the organisers in the original and kept, as a copy, on file at the organising company of each event. Foreigners who are non-residents may be issued with a medical certificate in their own country, but the same examinations required by Italian law must have been carried out: a) medical examination; b) complete urine test; c) electrocardiogram at rest and after effort; d) spirography.

3.. Athletes in possession of a FIDAL Runcard - www.runcard.com (valid as sports insurance and permission to compete), limited to athletes who have reached 20 years of age (one thousandth of age), whose participation is however subject to:

A valid medical certificate of specific agonistic fitness for athletics, which must be presented to the organisers in the original and kept, in copy, on file at the organising company of each event. Foreigners who are non-residents may be issued with a medical certificate in their own country, but the same examinations required by Italian law must have been carried out: a) medical examination; b) complete urine test; c) electrocardiogram at rest and after effort; d) spirography.

- 4. Disabled athletes registered for 2025 with clubs affiliated to one of the following Paralympic Sports Federations recognised by the CIP (Italian Paralympic Committee):
- FISPES (Italian Federation of Paralympic and Experimental Sports);
- FSSI (Federazione Sport Sordi Italia).

In this case, athletes must present a copy of their valid membership card (2025), or a declaration of membership on club letterhead with stamp and signature of the president.

For safety reasons related to the conformation of the route in the City, handbike athletes are not allowed to participate, whether they are UCI, FCI, EPS or for other recognised organisations or even non-members.

Foreign athletes wishing to take part in the event must comply with current Italian legislation on health protection and compulsory insurance cover. In the event of registration of athletes in an Olympic wheelchair with a declared race time of less than 1h30', the organisation reserves the right to provide for a controlled pace, as the city course will be closed to traffic according to the passage times.

5. You can apply for membership of Atleticom ASD by sending an email to *info@asdatleticom.it* and our staff will promptly reply giving you all the relevant information.

In accordance with FIDAL regulations, participation in the competitive race is not permitted with only a competitive medical certificate. Medical certificates that do not specifically mention Athletics as a sport practised are also not permitted.

Athletes registered abroad

Italian athletes registered abroad, who have reached the age of 16 years (thousandths of an age) on the date of the event, may participate with the following requirements:

- 1. Athletes in possession of a FIDAL Runcard www.runcard.com (valid as sports insurance and authorisation to compete), limited to athletes who have reached 20 years or over (thousandths of age), combined with a valid medical certificate of competitive fitness specific to the practice of athletics, which must be uploaded at the time of registration. Participation is however subject to:
- 2. A valid medical certificate of specific fitness for athletics, which must be presented to the organisers in the original and a copy kept on file at the organising company of each event.

Foreigners who are non-residents may be issued with a medical certificate in their own country, but the same examinations required by Italian law must have been carried out: a) medical examination; b) complete urine test; c) electrocardiogram at rest and after effort; d) spirography. 3. Athletes registered with clubs affiliated to Foreign Athletics Federations should upload a self-certification document at the time of registration proving of their membership to the club (the appropriate form can be requested by emailing werunrome@atleticom.it).

3 - Participation Requirements 10 and 5Km Non-Competitive

The recreational motor event includes two non-competitive trials over distances of 10 km and 5 km respectively.

For the 10 km race, anyone aged 14 years or over on the date of the event may register. For the 5 km non-competitive race there are no age limits; children up to the age of 13 must be accompanied by a parent/legal guardian.

For the participation of minors, a special authorisation form signed by a parent/legal guardian must be completed and uploaded during registration. The form can be downloaded online directly during the registration phase or can be requested by emailing werunrome@atleticom.it.

Registration for the event implies the tacit declaration of self-certification of physical fitness for the practice of 'non-competitive' sporting activity in accordance with the relevant regulations in force and therefore exempts the organisers from requesting a medical certificate.

The participant relieves the Organising Committee and its partners of all responsibility regarding his or her physical fitness to take part in the event and of all liability, both civil and criminal, for damage to persons and/or property caused by him or her or caused to him or her by participation in the race. He also declares that he grants his authorisation to use any of his images relating to his participation in the event for any legitimate use without remuneration.

Participation with hand-pushed wheelchairs is permitted in the non-competitive events, while bicycles or any other means of transport are not permitted.

For the 10 km non-competitive race there is no ranking list, but only an alphabetical list with the athlete's chronometric result.

For the 5 km non-competitive race, there is no timekeeping and no ranking.

4 - Registration

Registration is possible online at www.werunrome.com until 29 December.

The Organising Committee reserves the right to close registrations early or accept new ones after the closing date, at its sole discretion.

Registrations are open to the first 10,000 athletes who have finalised their registration with payment. The amount of the registration fee will vary according to the reference period, with priority given to those who register early.

If any bibs remain available, registration will be possible in person on the bib collection days and on the day of the event itself.

Any availability will be communicated on the website www.werunrome.com or via the event's social accounts.

GROUP REGISTRATIONS

• For group registrations of at least five people, from 1 august, it will be possible to register at special, customised rates by emailing gruppi@werunrome.com or calling 375-7371632.

PARTICIPATION OF ATHLETES WITH DISABILITIES

• The event is also open to athletes with disabilities, who can participate free of charge using either a Joelette or a handcycle. Please contact the administrative office at the above e-mail address and telephone number.

PRE-RACE CONTROL OF WHEELCHAIRS

- The race control is entrusted to the FISPES and FIDAL race judges, who will be entitled to disqualify athletes who do not comply with the instructions given.
- The road-opening vehicle will set the race speed and must never be exceeded by competitors.
- The use of helmets is compulsory for athletes in wheelchairs and of bibs for guideathletes.

Age of participation in the three types of competition

10 K Non-competitive - Participants from 14 years of age (born in 2011);

5 K Non-Competitive - Participation open to everyone without age limit;

10 K Competitive - Participants from the age of 16 years (born in 2009) with FIDAL membership or RUNCARD FIDAL/EPS.

4.1 - Modification of entries

It will not be possible to make changes to entries from 21 December to the day of the event.

5 - Participation fee

The registration fee, for all athletes in the competitive and non-competitive events (5 and 10 km) includes:

- race bib;
- RTC insurance;

- medical and technical assistance;
- official event T-shirt (subject to availability);
- refreshments along the route and at the finish line;
- timing service (only for 10 km);
- bag deposit service;
- any products and/or opportunities offered by sponsors;
- medal for all finishers (subject to availability);

6 - Registration and Payment

Registration can be done online at www.werunrome.com.

Payment can be made in one of the following ways:

It is also possible to make cumulative bank transfers for several athletes, in which case the names of all those to whom the payment is affiliated must be indicated in the reason for payment. Registration will only be effective upon receipt of the bank transfer.

7 - Refund of Participation Fees and Transfer

Registration fees are not refundable under any circumstances.

Should a registered athlete be unable to take part in the We Run Rome 2024, he/she may transfer the registration to another athlete by communicating all the necessary data and documents of the successor to werunrome@atleticom.it by the date of 22 December, or postpone the registration to the following year. (details on points 7.1 and 7.2)

7.1 Transferring an entry to another Athlete

The transfer of an entry for those who have already completed their registration will be free of charge until 2 December, from 3 to 22 December, a secretarial fee of €5.00 will be payable for each transfer.

7.2 Transfer to 2025

It is possible to postpone one's registration to 2025 until 22 December, until 2 December the postponement is free of charge, from 3 to 22 December the postponement will be possible against payment of € 5.00 for secretariat fees. From 23 December to the day of the event it will no longer be possible to postpone your registration, but you will still be able to receive your race kit.

Registrants who had already postponed their registration in 2023 will not be able to postpone it any further.

8 - Clubs registrations

For Clubs with fewer than 10 participants, it will be mandatory to register directly online at www.werunrome.com.

Clubs with more than 10 participants must send their entry list in excel format to the email werunrome@atleticom.it.

To request the compilation of the standard file, please send an email to werunrome@atleticom.it.

9 - Clubs payment

The registration manager of the Club with more than 10 participants must send an email to werunrome@atleticom.it enclosing a single payment for all the athletes of the same club. He/she must send the list of athletes in excel format for whom he/she has made the payment together with the payment slip.

10 - Bib and race packet collection

All information regarding the location, days and times of pick-up will be communicated later on the website www.werunrome.com and on the event's social channels.

Only and exclusively non-residents in Rome and foreign participants will have the additional possibility of collection on Sunday 31st December from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. at the Stadium of Terme di Caracalla. Collection by proxy will be possible, in which case the delegate must be in possession of all the participant's documentation.

11 - Bib's and race pack pick-up

For running clubs, all information regarding the location, days and times of pick-up will be communicated later on the website *www.werunrome.com* and on the event's social channels. Each club that has sent in its own entry list must indicate its own contact person who will collect the bibs and race packs for the entire

team. In order to facilitate the collection, it is advisable to make an appointment by sending an email to werunrome@atleticom.it.

The bib and race pack cannot be collected individually by athletes belonging to clubs that have registered cumulatively.

It will be possible on the day of the event, at the Terme di Caracalla Stadium, to collect one's own bib and race pack only for companies' resident outside the province of Rome from 10.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m.

12 - Bib number

The race bib is strictly personal, cannot be tampered with and is not transferable to anyone, as it is specifically associated with the athlete registered for the event. Bib numbers will be assigned at the sole discretion of the Organising Committee, only to athletes whose registration is complete with payment of the fee. Once a bib number has been assigned, it will not be possible to change it.

13 - Criteria for Assigning Bib Numbers

Bib numbers will be allocated at the sole discretion of the Organising Committee.

The "personal best times" declared at the time of registration will be taken into account for the allocation after checking them.

The times declared must relate to official certified 10 km races between 2022 and 2024. Time results in non-certified races will not be taken into account.

Athletes with personal bests of less than 40' (men) and 45' (women), and who indicate this when registering by 3 December, will be reserved a bib number corresponding to the first starting grid (non-elite), exclusively for the first 200 men and 100 women.

The bibs dedicated to the first grid (non-elite) will be subject to availability and will not be guaranteed after 3 December.

It is possible by sending an e-mail to werunrome@atleticom.it to indicate your 'personal best' over the 10 km distance. Top athletes or their companies must apply for a bib number for entry to the top runner grid at the time of registration. For the allocation of the bib numbers in the first grid (non-elite), the Organising Committee will carry out the relevant checks, therefore, if there is no effective feedback on the declared times, no numbers will be allocated in the first grid.

Top Athletes are women and men in possession of bib numbers 1 to 30.

14 - Composition of Starting Grids

The composition of the starting grids is as follows:

- Top Athletes;
- Competitive Athletes with personal bests under 40' (men) and 45' (women);
- Competitive Athletes with personal bests over 40' (men) and 45' (women);
- Athletes 10 km Non-Competitive;
- Athletes 5 km Non-Competitive.

The allocation of bibs for the competitive race will be at the sole discretion of the Organising Committee.

15 - Race Start

The start of the competitive and non-competitive 10 km race will be concomitant, given in Via delle Terme di Caracalla at 14:00. The 5 km race will start a few minutes later. The maximum time to complete the race is 120', after which time there will be no further blocking of traffic.

16 - Elite Athletes

Athletes in the race considered elite by the organisation, will be identified by the colour of their bib. The first 30 bibs will be reserved for the elite bracket.

17 - Individual prizes

Prizes will be awarded to the first three men and the first three women to reach the finish line in the competitive race. In addition, in the competitive race, prizes will be awarded to the first 3 finishers in each FIDAL category. Excluded from the category awards are the first 3 men and the first 3 women in the overall classification and athletes holding bib numbers 1 to 50. The category prizes are as follows:

- 1st place in each category wins a 100% discount voucher for the We Run Rome 2024;
- 2nd place of each category wins a 50% discount voucher for the We Run Rome 2024;
- 3rd place in each category wins a 25% discount voucher for the We Run Rome 2024.

When determining the final classification, the Gun Time (the kick-off shot), will be taken into account.

No prizes will be awarded for the non-competitive races.

18 - Award Ceremony

The Award Ceremony will be held at the end of the race, inside the Stadium of the Terme of Caracalla. The first 3 men and the first 3 women to reach the finish line of the competitive race will be the winners. There will be no category prize-giving; the relevant discount codes will be sent directly at the opening of the registration to the e-mail addresses of the winners.

No awards will be given for the non-competitive races.

19 - Club's Awards

Atleticom We Run Rome adheres to the Grand Slam of Running City of Rome, which includes the following events:

The club classification for clubs in the Lazio Region will be drawn up on the basis of the sum of the number of participants in the six competitive events. Therefore, the participants taking part in the non-competitive events linked to the events will be excluded. Clubs will be ranked if at least 10 athletes arrive at the finish line in each of the events.

Clubs will be ranked if at least 10 athletes arrive at the finish line in each of the six events.

The prize money will be paid out within 90 days from the date of the event. Gun Time will be taken into consideration for the awarding of the prize money. No prize money (or similar: generic value vouchers, bonuses, engagements, reimbursement of expenses of any kind and for any reason whatsoever) may be envisaged for athletes in the Beginners, Juniors, Cadets, Pupils categories, for "Runcard" and "Runcard EPS" holders.

An extra bonus of € 1,000.00 is envisaged for athletes who improve the event record.

The event record is:

On the amount of the prizes, as provided for by Article 30 of Presidential Decree 600/1973 (Sports Reform) as of 01/07/23, withholding taxes of 20% for Italian athletes and 30% for foreign athletes will be applied, for which ASD Atleticom will be withholding tax, and will pay these amounts by means of F24.

22 - Race course 5Km

23 - Refreshments

There will be two refreshments for both the competitive and non-competitive 10 km race: an intermediate one at the 5th km and a final one at the finish line. A refreshment point at the finish line is provided for the 5 km race.

24 - Deposit Bags and Changing Rooms

There will be designated stands at the Atleticom We Run Rome village, where you can leave your personal belongings. We recommend that you do not deposit valuables in them. Two changing rooms will be also available, one for men and one for women.

25 - Health Service

Sanitary facilities will be set up along the entire race route and at the finish line.

26 - Privacy policy

Personal data, the provision of which is compulsory for the purposes of registration to Atleticom We Run Rome, shall be processed pursuant to and in accordance with the provisions of art. 13 of the European Regulation 2016/679 on the protection of personal data ("GDPR") and of the National Privacy Policy. The same data indicated at the time of registration will be used to prepare the list of participants, the rankings, for historical archives, to carry out the services declared in the regulations and to send information material from Atleticom We Run Rome or its partners. At any time, the person concerned may consult, modify, delete his/her data free of charge by writing to the person in charge of personal data processing at Atleticom SSD.r.L, Piazza Giacomo Matteotti 3, 00010 Montelibretti (RM).

27 - Image Rights

By registering for the We Run Rome, the athlete expressly authorises the Organising Committee, sponsors, third parties working on his behalf and media partners to use the still or moving images that may depict him/her during his/her participation in the race, on all supports, including promotional and/or advertising materials, all over the world and for the maximum time foreseen by the laws, regulations and treaties in force, including any possible extension that may be made to the foreseen period.

28 - Timekeeping and Classifications

The timekeeping service and the processing of the rankings will be provided by an external company and they will be validated by the Technical Delegate Judge/Appellate Judge. The chip will be disposable and therefore will not be returned at the end of the race.

29 - Complaints

Any protests regarding the classification must be made within 30 minutes of the display of the official classification.

of the official classification, in the first instance verbally to the Arrival Judge and in the second instance in writing to the Appeal Judge, accompanied by the fee of €100.00 which will be returned if the complaint is upheld. For anything not expressly provided for, please refer to the FIDAL general regulations and the R.T.I.

30 - Unforeseen impossibility

In the event that the race is cancelled and/or postponed to another date, or in any case, not held for causes or reasons not attributable and/or not attributable to the will of the Organisation, including the revocation of the authorisation to hold the race by the competent Public Bodies, the participant will have nothing to claim from Atleticom SSDrL either for the return of the amount paid for registration, or by way of reimbursement of any expenses incurred or to be incurred.

The registration has the value of acceptance of this clause and as an express waiver of any claim resulting from the cancellation and/or postponement of the race, whether relating to compensation for any damage suffered or to be suffered and/or for indemnity and/or for any other reintegrating and/or satisfactory claim for any pecuniary or non-pecuniary prejudice suffered or to be suffered.

31 - Exemption from Responsibility

The subscriber is responsible for the ownership and safekeeping of his or her race bib, the presentation of which guarantees the right to use all services mentioned in these regulations and subsequently communicated.

- 1. Anyone who, without regular registration, takes part without a race bib, in addition to being held liable for damage to persons or property, including himself, will incur sporting sanctions under the jurisdiction of the federal bodies and may be liable to the criminal sanctions provided for the offence of "theft" (art. 524. penal code).
- 2. Anyone who, without regular registration, takes part with a forged or otherwise non-compliant bib, or with another person's bib, as well as being liable as indicated above, will incur sporting penalties and may

also be liable to the criminal penalties provided for the offence of "theft" (art. 524. criminal code), or, alternatively, for the offence of fraud (art. 540. criminal code).

In cases 1) and 2), participants may be liable to the penalties laid down for the offence of "failure to comply with the provisions of the Authorities" (Article 550 of the criminal code). The aforementioned cases will be verified by means of photographic and/or video documentation.

It is forbidden to enter grids other than those assigned at the time of registration, as well as to throw, inside the starting grids and on the competition route, T-shirts, capes or any other object that may cause obstruction or the fall of athletes passing by afterwards. In the event of a violation, the athlete will be held liable for the damage caused, with consequent criminal and civil action.

It is forbidden to "cut" the established route and/or take short cuts and/or enter the race course from a different point than the starting line. Failure to comply with this obligation will result in the disqualification of the athlete, as well as the liability of the athlete for any damage caused to third parties.

32 - Exemption from Liability
