

OFFICIAL REGULATIONS

27th PISA MARATHON – “LA PISANINA” HALF MARATHON – CHRISTMAS RUN

Sunday, 20 December 2026 – Pisa, Italy

ART. 1 – EVENT

On **Sunday, 20 December 2026**, the **27th edition of the Pisa Marathon** will take place in Pisa. The event is included in the **FIDAL** and **AIMS – World Athletics** calendars and consists of the following races:

- **Pisa Marathon** – 42.195 km (competitive and non-competitive)
- **“La Pisanina” Half Marathon** – 21.097 km (competitive and non-competitive)
- **Christmas Run** – non-competitive race

The start of the competitive races is scheduled for **9:00 a.m.**

ART. 2 – COURSE

The course is **entirely asphalted**, officially measured and certified by **FIDAL and AIMS – World Athletics**, with start and finish in the historic city center of Pisa.

The route includes:

Lungarni – Porta a Mare – La Vettola – San Piero a Grado – Via Bigattiera – Tirrenia – Marina di Pisa – Viale D’Annunzio – Ponte della Cittadella – Via Roma – Via Santa Maria – Piazza del Duomo.

Refreshment stations every **5 km**.

ART. 3 – DATE, SCHEDULE AND START

- Athletes’ meeting: **8:00 a.m.**
- Opening of starting grids: **8:00 a.m.**
- Closing of starting grids: **8:45 a.m.**
- Start Marathon & Half Marathon: **9:00 a.m.**
- Start Christmas Run: **9:15 a.m.**

Start area: **Largo Cocco Griffi – Pisa**

ART. 4 – PARTICIPATION

4.1 Pisa Marathon – 42.195 km

Participation is open to athletes **born in 2006 or earlier**, provided they meet one of the following requirements:

- **FIDAL** membership
- **FIDAL RunCard** + valid competitive medical certificate for athletics
- **RunCard EPS** (Athletics section) + valid competitive medical certificate
- Membership of **foreign Athletics Federations affiliated with World Athletics**
- **Non-registered foreign athletes**, allowed only in **non-competitive tourist/sport mode** (excluded from rankings and prize money)

4.2 “La Pisanina” Half Marathon – 21.097 km

Participation is open to athletes **born in 2008 or earlier**, under the same membership conditions as the Marathon.

4.3 Christmas Run

The Christmas Run is a **non-competitive event**, open to all.
No official rankings or prize ceremonies are provided.

ART. 5 – REGISTRATION

Registration is **online only** via the official website:
www.maratonadipisa.com

To register, the following are required:

- Completed registration form
- Payment of the entry fee
- Valid membership documentation
- Competitive medical certificate (where required)

Participation without valid registration or payment receipt is **not allowed**.

ART. 6 – ENTRY FEES AND LIMITS

- Maximum number of participants: **4,500**
 - Marathon: **2,200**
 - Half Marathon: **2,300**
- Christmas Run: maximum **500 participants**

Entry fees are available directly on the online registration form.

ART. 7 – NON-PARTICIPATION

Entry fees are **non-refundable**.

By **9 December 2026**, registered athletes may:

1. **Transfer their entry to the 2027 edition** (€10.00 administrative fee)
2. **Transfer their entry to another athlete** (€10.00 administrative fee)

Each option may be used **only once**.

ART. 8 – BIB COLLECTION

Bib numbers and race kits can be collected at the **Marathon Expo Village**:

- **Friday, 18 December**: 12:00 – 8:00 p.m.
- **Saturday, 19 December**: 10:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m.

Required documents:

- Valid ID
- Requested sports documentation

Bib collection on behalf of another runner is allowed **for one person only**, with written authorization.

ART. 9 – BIB NUMBER

The race bib is **personal and non-transferable**.
It must be worn **on the front and clearly visible**.

Any alteration or exchange will result in **disqualification**.

ART. 10 – TIMING

Official timing will be provided by **Evodata** using **MyLaps** chip technology integrated into the bib.

- Official ranking time: **Gun Time**
- Individual performance time: **Real Time**

ART. 11 – TIME LIMITS

- Marathon: **6 hours 30 minutes**
- Half Marathon: **3 hours 15 minutes**
- Marathon intermediate cut-off at 30 km: **4 hours 35 minutes**

Athletes running slower than **8'30" per km** must comply with the Italian Road Traffic Code.

ART. 12 – SERVICES

All registered participants are entitled to:

- Race kit
- Refreshments
- Medical assistance
- Finisher medal
- Downloadable online certificate
- Bag drop service

Showers and changing rooms are not provided.

ART. 13 – RANKINGS AND AWARDS

The following lists will be drawn up:

- **FIDAL official competitive rankings**
- Non-competitive finishers list

Awards:

- **Top 10 overall men and women**
- Podium ceremony for **top 3 men and top 3 women**

No age-group awards are provided.

ART. 14 – PRIZE MONEY

Prize money is awarded according to the official **Marathon and Half Marathon tables**.
An additional **€1,000.00 record bonus** is awarded for breaking the event record in the Marathon.

ART. 15 – BAG DROP

Bag drop service will be available from **7:00 a.m.** in the Via Duomo area.
Bag drop closes at **8:30 a.m.**

ART. 16 – IMAGE RIGHTS

By registering, athletes grant the organizer the **unlimited and free right** to use images and videos taken during the event for promotional and communication purposes.

ART. 17 – LIABILITY DISCLAIMER

By signing the registration form, the athlete declares full knowledge and acceptance of these regulations and releases the organizers from any civil or criminal liability for damages caused to or suffered by persons or property.

ART. 18 – COMPLAINTS

Any complaints must be submitted in accordance with **FIDAL** and **World Athletics** regulations.

ART. 19 – FINAL PROVISIONS

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to modify these regulations for safety reasons or due to instructions from public authorities.
